##### Byodo-in Temple\*

Originally built in 998 in the Heian period and formerly the villa of “Fujiwara-no-Michinaga”, Byodo-in Temple was converted into a temple in 1052. The temple’s graceful architecture, as well as the majestic garden and surrounding scenery, conjures up a vision of the magical paradise dreamed of by the Heian aristocracy. The Phoenix Hall of **Byodo-in** Temple is printed on the Japanese 10 yen coin.



##### Tea Ceremony & a Matcha Green-Tea-Powder Making Experience at the Historical Tea Maker ‘Nakamura Tokichi Honten’.

You will experience making matcha green tea powder from dried tea leaves, as well as a tea ceremony at a traditional tea house. You will enjoy drinking matcha green tea produced from your handmade green tea powder.



##### Lunch

Lunch will be provided at the famous Japanese restaurant “Shokado Kitcho”



##### Shokado Garden

Experience the scenic beauty of 40 types of bamboo and 200 precious tea flowers “Tsubaki”, as well as 4 different styles of tea house located in the outer garden.



##### Fushimi Inari Shrine

This famous shrine is known for the Senbon-torii (thousands of traditional Japanese gates) which are located on the path leading to the inner shrine.
