**To all of the participants, we thank you in advance for your cooperation to abide by
the rules and regulations listed below so that everyone can enjoy the event together!**

To all of the participants:

- Registration is required at the reception area in the Granvia Terrace, Located on the 3rd Floor at the East Zone of the Kyoto Station Building (up the escalator located outside the hotel lobby)
- Participants are strongly recommended to keep all **valuable items** such as phones, wallets, and purses with them at all times. The hotel will not be held responsible for any lost, stolen, missing, or damaged personal items belonging to the participants.
- When taking photos of 'cosplayers', be sure to obtain permission from the target individuals prior to taking the photo. In addition, to avoid including unrelated persons in the picture, take photos at a secluded place, such as near a background wall, etc.
- If you wish to post the photos on a personal website, blog, or a Facebook page, please be sure to obtain prior approval from the relevant individuals.
- Furthermore, if complaints are received or if any other negative issue arises, the hotel might demand that you stop participating in the 'cosplaying' activities.

For those who plan to participate in 'cosplay':

- 'Cosplayers' are required to change their clothes at the designated "**Angelbe**" dressing room located on the 2nd floor of the Kyoto Theater. Please note that use of this particular dressing room is reserved for females only.
*At the reception area you will be given a voucher that is good for one hour of dressing room usage. The voucher is valid for one hour between 15:00 and 16:30, and for 30 minutes between 16:30 and 20:30. Additional usage time is available for JPY200 per 30 minutes.
- For the location of the male dressing room, please ask hotel staff at the reception area.
- Cosplay activities and the taking of photographs will only be allowed at designated areas.
Coming into or leaving the venue while wearing your cosplay costume is prohibited.
- Cosplay is only allowed for the guests who change into their costume at the designated dressing rooms.
- Please note that the following costumes will not be permitted. If any rules are found to be violated, we ask for your understanding that the relevant cosplayers may be asked to stop participating in the cosplay activities.

Arms and weapons such as guns, swords, and any other harmful items.

Pointed attachments on costumes, such as helmets and armor, are also not permitted.

Items that could inflict injury or damage to persons or property.

Do not bring in items that can be thrown around, such as balls and disks.

Costumes that are disturbing to others

Costumes in the form of any existing uniforms such as police, security, military, etc. are strictly prohibited. Blood-stained costumes are not allowed. In addition, costumes that remind people of certain known individuals, costumes that evoke racial discrimination, and revealing costumes are strictly prohibited. It is also prohibited for gentlemen to wear "ladylike" costumes. The use of combustible and highly inflammable materials and chemical items that emit strong odors is strictly prohibited.
