Course destinations include:

Kozan-ji Temple*

Established at the start of the 13th century, Kozan-ji Temple is lush with ancient cedar and maple trees, and the surrounding grounds have been designated as a national historic site. This temple contains the oldest tea field in Japan, planted with seeds brought from China by the Zen priest Eisai.



Saiho-ji Temple*

As known as Koke-dera Temple, or the 'Moss' Temple because of its 120 varieties of mosses that create a magical carpet throughout the temple grounds. You will also experience Shakyo, or Sutra copying (writing the sacred words of Buddha) during the tour.

Tenryu-ji Temple*

Established in 1339 by "Shogun Ashikaga Takauji", Tenryu-ji Temple is the first-ranked of the Five Great Zen Temples of Kyoto. It has been designated as a Special Historic Site and a Special Historic Scenic Area, with the surrounding landscapes displaying the exquisite beauty of the four seasons.
